

Architects in the Age of IT – Information Management and IT in the Architectural Practices

Coordination and collaboration across the construction industry supply chain holds the greatest potential for the improvement of efficiency in the process. This paper presents the results of a recent survey of IT usage in architectural practices in Australia and Asia, which was designed to capture information about the range of activities undertaken by architects that reflect the level of adoption of IT. The results illustrate the current state of industry practice, providing a basis for benchmarking future change as well as providing a glimpse of the future as anticipated by practitioners.
